

Schedule Your Adoption Informational Meeting

The next step is to schedule a free meeting with one of our admissions directors. This hour-long, virtual meeting is packed with valuable information about adoption and our process. It's also the perfect opportunity for you to ask any questions that you may have. You'll leave this meeting with a clear understanding of our services so that you can determine if we are the right fit for your family's adoption needs. **To schedule your meeting, call 877-264-3555 or text the word "MEETING" to 815-528-2178.**

Start the Adoption Home Study

All adoptive families are legally required to complete a home study. During this process, a social worker will evaluate your family's overall readiness to adopt and the safety of your home. This can take two to four months. If you don't already have a home study provider, we will refer you to one of our partners.

Complete Adoption Education Courses

To help prepare you for your adoption journey, you'll complete a series of nine online education courses. Each course focuses on a specific adoption-related topic, complete with a one-hour audio lesson followed by a tenquestion quiz. You must successfully pass each course before moving on to the next stage of our process.

Create Your Adoptive Family Profile

Once you've completed your education requirements, we'll connect you with our profile development team. They will turn the content and photos you provide into a custom adoptive family profile and corresponding online profile. We'll then begin presenting your profile to prospective birthmothers. Your web profile will be available to anyone searching for adoptive families online.

Connect With a Birthmother

When an expectant mother selects your profile, your adoption coordinator will contact you right away to establish communication via phone, text, or email.

Legal Services & Financial Assistance

When an expectant mother is ready to connect with you, we'll refer you to an attorney in her state. You'll retain them on her behalf and begin providing the expectant mother with financial support. You can continue communicating at her comfort level. If the adoption plan does not proceed for any reason, we will resume your marketing and advertising efforts.

Travel for the Birth Experience

When the expectant mother goes into labor, what occurs at the hospital is determined by her wishes. Some birthmothers allow adoptive parents in the delivery room, while some adoptive families can't make it to the hospital until after the birth. The birthmother may want to see her baby or meet you, but she may not want to do either.

Bring Your Baby Home & Finalize Your Adoption

Revocation periods and finalization timelines vary from state to state. If the baby is born outside your home state, you must stay in the birth state until all necessary legal paperwork is processed. This usually takes 7–10 days. Then you can legally travel home with your new baby.




The marketing and advertising portion of your contract fee covers three main areas. Here's a breakdown of each.

frequently asked questions

What is your success rate?

We measure our success by the number of adoptive families chosen by prospective birthmothers. Most families are selected multiple times throughout their journey.

How long will it take me to adopt?

The adoption timeline is entirely unpredictable. We have no control over what happens after an initial connection, making it impossible to predict how long it will take a family to successfully adopt. While the wait is typically between 6 to 24 months, the process can take longer.

Can I choose the gender and/or race of my baby?

While we accommodate preferences for gender and/or race, specific criteria usually results in a longer wait time. We encourage hopeful parents to be as open with their preferences as they are comfortable with to increase the likelihood of connecting with an expectant mother.

What are the different types of adoption?

Adoptions can be open, semi-open, or closed, each of which are based entirely on the birthmother's preference. Open adoptions involve direct communication and annual visits with the birthmother. Semi-open adoptions allow for some communication without in-person visits. Closed adoptions require little to no communication with the birthmother. Most of the birthmothers we work with opt for an open adoption.

What does expectant mother financial support involve?

Expectant mothers almost always require financial assistance for living and pregnancy-related expenses. A social worker will assess your birthmother's needs and outline a financial support plan based on her situation and any applicable laws in her state. Support covers reasonable pregnancy-related living expenses, such as rent, food, utilities, maternity clothes, and transportation.

Is there a scam risk?

Unfortunately, adoption scams are always a potential risk. Our team strives to mitigate this risk early on, although our capacity to do so is limited. Legally, we cannot conduct background checks, or request medical records. We operate on the basis of trust so that we can provide prospective birthmothers a safe, non-judgmental environment to explore their options.

What if an expectant mother changes her mind?

Adoption is voluntary for both the birth parents and the adoptive parents. Until legal finalization, expectant mothers have the right to change their mind at any point. While some expectant mothers do ultimately decide against adoption, we always support their choice. If this happens to your family, your coordinator will be there to offer support and discuss your options moving forward. We will resume your marketing and advertising efforts whenever you're ready.

Adoption Program Fees

We charge a flat fee for our marketing and advertising services.
