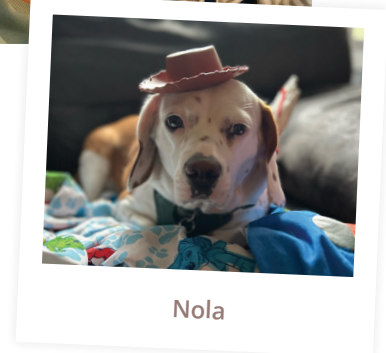
MY FAMILY & PETS
